Rhomboid major and minor are inferior to where the levator scapulae is. Strength Testing: Position – the subject in prone with the arm at the edge of the table on the side being tested. The elbow is flexed; the humerus is adducted toward the side of the body in slight extension and slight lateral rotation.

Rhomboid Major/Minor and Levator Scapulae

They consist of two functionally similar muscles called rhomboid minor and rhomboid major. Together with trapezius, levator scapulae and latissimus dorsi, they comprise the superficial layer of the extrinsic back muscles. The rhomboid muscles extend between the nuchal ligament, spinous processes of thoracic vertebrae and scapula. Under innervation from the dorsal scapular nerve, the rhomboids primarily retract the scapula superomedially and rotate the glenoid cavity.
