If your vehicle is not parallel to the curb, drive forward to straighten. When you are properly parked, set the parking brake and move the gear selector into park, or shift into first or reverse gear if your vehicle has a manual transmission. Turn off the engine. Remember to remove the key from the ignition. Check traffic before opening your door.

Which direction you turn them depends on which side of the hill you're on. Turn away from the curb when parking uphill and toward the curb when parking downhill. Put your vehicle in park or first gear (for manual transmissions) to keep it from rolling freely. Set the parking or emergency brake as a backup in case other systems fail.

Manual Transmission Without Parking Brake

Set the parking brake and shift to park with an automatic transmission or reverse with a manual transmission. Turn off the engine and lock the vehicle. Florida law requires that you take the keys out of your vehicle before leaving it. Always check traffic behind you before getting out, or get out on the curb side.

Once the vehicle width lines and the sides of the parking space on the left and right are parallel, straighten the wheels and back the vehicle slowly into the parking space. Continue checking the vehicle's surroundings and then stop the vehicle in the best possible position.
