Dingo is a game for four players using a standard deck of 52 cards. The diamonds in the pack are called the 'rabbits'. The Ace of diamonds in the main pack is called the 'Ace rabbit'. The hearts are called 'dingoes' and have special importance in this game.

For smaller animals, dingoes hunt alone, usually at night, but for larger prey, they will hunt in packs. The Dingo Fence. Dingoes became so well-known for hunting and eating sheep and other farm animals that in the 1880's it was decided to build a huge fence to keep dingoes out of the south-east of Australia.

To initiate the hunt, the dealer announces the value of the top card of the rabbit pile. A player with a dingo of the same rank MUST play it (face-up).
